



 - A surge of Internet-based drug transaction
 - A popular transit point for illicit drug trafficking
 - Increase of Korean-national Couriers involved in trafficking
 - New trend in of S.E Asian Countries
 - Eradicated the Cultivation of Opium
 - Facing increasing manufacture of Methamphetamine

Foreign nationals arrested for drug-related offences in Korea increased mainly due to:


- (1) Simplified immigration process to attract more foreign tourists
- (2) Drug trafficking & abuse by illegal immigrants from S.E. Asia and English inst ructors from English-speaking area such as U.S., Canada and UK.
